

NOTIFICATION

G.S.R.-..... In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules to amend the Indian Broadcasting (Programme) Service Rules, 1990, namely:-

1. These rules may be called the Indian Broadcasting (Programme) Service (Amendment) Rules, 2018.
2. These rules come into effect from 22nd March 2016, the date on which the revised DPC composition was issued by this Ministry. This amendment shall not affect anything done or action taken under the rules prior to this amendment.
3. In the Indian Broadcasting (Programme) Service Rules, 1990 (hereinafter referred to as the principal rules),-
 - (a) In Rule 2 (Definitions), clause (k), after the words "in the pay scale of", the words "Rs. 2000-3500" shall be replaced by the words "Level-7 in the Pay Matrix" and the words "including Programme Executive (Selection Grade)" shall be deleted;
 - (b) In Rule 7, in sub-rule (2), in clause (a), the words "conducted by the Commission" and the words "in consultation with the Commission" shall be deleted;

- (c) In Rule 7, in sub-rule (6), in clause (b), in sub-clause (i), the word "field" shall be replaced by the word "zone" and the words "specialised discipline in the Programme Production Cadre of the respective media, mentioned in Schedule-VII" shall be replaced by the word "media";
- (d) In Rule 7, in sub-rule (6), in clause (b), in sub-clause (ii), the word "Department" shall be replaced by the word "Departmental" and the words "including the discipline" shall be deleted;
- (e) In Rule 13, the words "and in consultation with the Commission" shall be deleted;
- (f) In Rule 14, after the words "the Scheduled Tribes", the words ", the Other Backward Classes" shall be inserted;
- (g) In Rules 15, the words "in consultation with the Commission" shall be deleted;
- (h) In Schedule I, Table showing Grade, Number and Scale of Pay of Duty Posts, shall be replaced by the table given below:
